Drawing is at the heart of my practice with collage and collagraph printing approached as drawing with paper, preferring to collaborate with nature by using found objects & materials to make with wherever possible. My work is process-driven, ideas and concepts evolve through the making process, involving cycles of 'construct and break' with mark making and materials.
