Turton's art practice is informed by contemporary, abstract drawing. She is an associate member of <http://backlit.org.uk/info/> and part of the newly formed 'Outsider' artist collective. Work represents elements of the natural environment and takes on an almost meditative practice recording change over time.

Valerie Turton has exhibited widely across the UK and is currently working on a new exchange/collaboration between Backlit Gallery (Nottingham) and Tate Modern (London)

For the Honfleur exhibition I will be producing two framed pieces measuring approx 25x35cm. These will be a combination of found plant forms and drawing set behind metal plates.

I will also produce an accompanying book of abstract ink drawings that explore the cycle and changes that occur in natural plant growth throughout the seasons. The book will be approx 70cmx20cm and would be best displayed on a shelf at standing height below the framed images or on a suitably sized plinth. The book will not be for sale but could act as examples of further possible commissions.
